

Housing Authority of the City of Reno
Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 Proposed Amendment

The Housing Authority of the City of Reno (RHA) is proposing an amendment to the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP2) plan. NSP2 has been in effect for three years and the initial grant period will end February 11, 2013. Once the initial grant period is complete, RHA proposes to expand the NSP2 target areas to include the following census tracts:
