MTW MOBILITY PROGRAM

For Residents in RHA Public Housing

For public housing residents who have demonstrated exemplary compliance with program rules, RHA offers a Moving to Work Mobility Program. That's a long name for a program that can get you out of public housing and into a single-family home or townhouse in a great neighborhood, all while retaining your eligibility for housing assistance. Sounds pretty good, doesn't it? Here are the details.

First, follow the rules

Residents with minor children who have lived at an RHA public housing complex for at least two years and have followed all rules and regulations in their lease agreements are eligible. The Mobility Program targets tenants who have no issues passing home inspections, have no lease violations, and consistently pay rent on time.

Get on the list and say yes!

When you've done the right things for 24 months, you'll receive a letter inquiring if you'd like to participate in the Mobility Program. Once part of the program, you'll be notified each time a new property becomes available. If the property seems like a good fit for your family and lifestyle, say yes! RHA will use a lottery system for each home to select from interested program participants.

Other Details

This program is currently open only to families with children in the household. When residing in a Mobility Program home, if the head of household becomes unemployed, they must take part in RHA's Workforce Development Program to assist getting back to work.

Most properties are renovated and are in well-established Reno-Sparks neighborhoods, but public transportation may not be near each home. If you don't have your own transportation, please check to see if public transportation is nearby before expressing your interest in a specific property.

Follow the rules, get on the list, and say yes to a single family home or townhouse!
