#### Coordinated Entry Access

Coordinated Entry is a local process that helps people who do not have a place to live find housing. It connects individuals and families experiencing homelessness with housing funded by HUD. When someone needs help finding a home, they can take an assessment called the Community Housing Assessment Tool (CHAT). Their CHAT score reflects a person's housing needs. People with higher scores get priority on the list for available housing. Northern Nevada uses the "no wrong door" approach to assessments. This means that various agencies in the community can help with CHAT assessments. Most people get assessed at the Nevada Cares Campus, but if you would like another choice you can visit

#### What happens when you go to a Coordinated Entry Site?

- 1. You will be asked to complete a short triage assessment to see if you are experiencing a crisis. If you are, immediate assistance or referrals will be provided.
- 2. The triage assessment will determine the housing assessment to be completed based upon your household type. The housing assessment helps determine your housing needs. Sometimes assessments show that a person might not be in need of housing options available. If that happens, the worker will refer you to other community resources that you might need.
- 3. If you do qualify for housing, you might not be matched or referred right away. You will be placed on a list called the "Community Queue" and matched to housing services in the community when resources become available.
- 4. It is important that you stay in touch with the worker at least once a month to get updates, so the worker knows you are still interested. If you do not stay in touch with the worker, you could be removed from the list.

It may include two or more persons with disabilities living together, or one or more persons with disabilities living with one or more live-in aides (refer to HUD Handbook 4350.2 Change 4, Figure 3-6, for further guidance).

# Reno, Nevada Payment Standards, Fair Market Rents, and Income Limits

The Public Housing Authority (PHA) determines a payment standard between 90% and 110% of Fair Market Rents (FMRs). In certain instances, the payment standard can be 120%. The FMRs are published annually by HUD and represent the cost to rent a moderately-priced dwelling unit in the local housing market. The housing voucher tenant must pay 30% (**unless there is no income**) of its monthly adjusted gross income for rent and utilities, and if the unit rent is greater than the payment standard, the tenant is required to pay the additional amount (limits and restrictions apply). <a href="https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/fmr.html">https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/fmr.html</a>

The payment standards are the maximum monthly assistance payment allowed for a Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) holder. The payment standards include rent and tenant paid utilities and are used to calculate the monthly Housing Assistance Payment (HAP) for the family.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) sets income limits that determine eligibility for assisted housing programs including the Public Housing, Section 8 project-based, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher, Section 202 housing for the elderly, and Section 811 housing for persons with disabilities programs. HUD develops income limits based on Median Family Income estimates and Fair Market Rent area definitions for each metropolitan area, parts of some metropolitan areas, and each non-metropolitan county.

Income Limit areas are based on FY 2023 Fair Market Rent (FMR) areas.
